BIS-SAHHA tas-setghat moghtija lilha bl-artikolu 49 ta' l-Att dwar l-Ippjanar ta' l-Iżvilupp, l-Awtorità ta' Malta dwar l-Ambjent u l-Ippjanar għamlet dan l-ordni li ġej:

**1.** Dan l-ordni jissejjah l-Ordni ta' l-2003 li jemenda l-Ordni ta' <sup>Titolu.</sup> l-1993 dwar Reklami, u għandu jinqara' u jiftiehem bhala haġa wahda flimkien ma' l-Ordni ta' l-1993 dwar Reklami, hawnhekk iżjed 'il <sup>A.L. 171 ta' l-1993.</sup> quddiem imsejha "l-ordni prinċipali".

**2.** Paragrafu (d) tas-subartikolu (1) tal-artiklu 4 ta' l-ordni prinċipali għandu jiġi sostitwit kif ġej:– <sup>Jemenda l-artiklu 4 ta' l-ordni prinċipali.</sup>

“(d) reklam li jirrigwarda esklussivament elezzjoni ġenerali jew referendum jew elezzjoni għall-kunsilli lokali u li jkun muri mhux aktar kmieni minn tliet xhur qabel u mhux aktar tard minn xahar wara l-ġurnata li fiha jkunu saru l-elezzjoni jew referendum imsemmija;”.

**DEVELOPMENT PLANNING ACT  
(CAP. 356)**

**Advertisements (Regulation) (Amendment) Order, 2003**

IN exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 49 of the Development Planning Act, the Malta Environment and Planning Authority has made the following regulations:

Citation and commencement.

L.N. 171 of 1993.

**1.** The title of these regulations is the Advertisements (Regulation) (Amendment) Order, 2003 and they shall be read and construed as one with the Advertisements (Regulation) Order 1993, hereinafter referred to as “the principal order”.

Amends Article 4 of the principal regulations.

**2.** Paragraph (d) of subarticle (1) of article 4 of the principal order shall be substituted as follows:–

“(d) an advertisement which relates exclusively to a general election or to a referendum or to an election for local councils and which is displayed not earlier than three months before and not later than one month after the date on which such an election or referendum is held;”.
