**EUROPEAN UNION ACT, 2003  
(ACT NO. V OF 2003)**

**Free Movement of Goods Order, 2004**

BY virtue of the powers conferred under article 4(2) of the European Union Act, 2003, the Prime Minister has made the following Order:

Citation and coming into force.

**1.** (1) The title of this Order is the Free Movement of Goods Order, 2004.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the 1st May, 2004.

Interpretation.

**2.** “Member State” means a state party to the Treaty.

Free movement of goods.

**3.** No provision of any law shall impede the importation, marketing and use of products legally produced and marketed in a Member State other than Malta, provided that such products ensure an equivalent level of protection as those that may legally be produced and marketed in Malta.

Repeals L.N. 293 of 2003.

**4.** The Free Movement of Goods Regulations, 2003, are hereby repealed.
